POLICY NAME	Licensure of Visiting Consultants
DESCRIPTION	<p>This Policy has been developed to address the applications of those physicians who apply for a Visiting Consultant Licence.</p> <p>In order to be eligible for licensure as a Visiting Consultant, the applicant would need to be providing to PEI patients a service that would normally require them to travel off Island for care, and would also have to be sponsored by Health PEI/Government. This service being provided to PEI patients would typically be clinics lasting for 1-2 days periodically.</p> <p>Further eligibility for licensure to practise as a Visiting Consultant in PEI, the physician must be, at the time of application, eligible for licensure on the Temporary & Limited Register, Full Register or Specialist Register. If the physician possesses a Full Time Academic clinical appointment at a Canadian Medical School, such Visiting Consultant license would cease immediately if such Medical School appointment concludes for any reason.</p>
